It is with great joy and excitement that we are introducing Point 11, a new camp managed by Kids Across America.

Our vision is to provide a safe Christian environment for continued spiritual growth. It is our mission to encourage others in their walk with Christ so we take as our lead verse 1 Thess. 5:11 which reads: "...encourage one another and build up one another..."

The process for registration is simple. To begin, please read the policies and procedures of Point 11 and complete the enclosed registration form detailing the number of persons you will bring and your contact information. You will need to return this signed form with your appropriate deposit of \$90 per person that you desire to register.

Once we have received these items you will be pre-registered for camp. We will send you a confirmation e-mail noting your acceptance and/or wait list status (if the session you request is full.) You will then receive materials needed to assist you and your group to prepare for POINT 11. Remember to copy all forms in this packet or any you send to us in the future for your records. Please keep in mind that all registration is on a first come, first served basis and early response is most ideal.

We look forward to encouraging you and your youth in your walk with Jesus Christ! Please feel free to contact us with any questions. It would be our delight to serve you.

POINT 11 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Please read these policies and procedures carefully. The group registration form must be signed stating you have read, understand and accept these policies. Your registration request will not be processed without your signature.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

Point 11 is a camp designed to meet the needs of Church and Para-Church Youth ages 11-18. You must have 2 leaders for every 12 campers and a leader for each gender. You are welcome to request additional leaders above the 2 to 12 ratio, however those leaders will not be approved until the session is confirmed as full. (Notices for additional openings may be made as late as 2 weeks prior to your session.) Please consult the registration team if your enrollment needs are different from what has been recommended. We will gladly take your request into consideration. The minimum age for each leader is 19 years old.

Point 11 is not a conducive environment for group members who are pregnant or have disabilities which require individualized care and/or extreme changes in our camp procedures. Such disabilities include, but are not limited to, the following: down syndrome, autism, sickle cell anemia, persons requiring use of a wheel chair or those with severe developmental delays. Persons with such medical situations are prohibited from attending POINT 11.

Each group must register a minimum of 10 campers unless otherwise allowed by Point 11.

COST

The tuition cost is as follows: ~~\$298~~ ~~\$200~~ per camper and adult leader. A deposit of ~~\$75~~ ~~\$50~~ per camper and leader is due when returning the registration form. The remaining balance is due in our office no later than 2 weeks prior to your camp session. If the full balance is not received in time, you run the risk of forfeiting your registered spaces.

All checks must be made out to Kids Across America with notation made on the check that you are registering for Point 11. Multiple checks or money orders from various supporters or

parents for the camper's deposit or tuition cannot be accepted. Parents and sponsors will need to make checks out to your church or organization: then one payment can be written to cover all deposit or tuition costs. Please note that any payments to our organization are not tax deductible.

All cancellations must be made in writing and in our office by 5 p.m. on May 1st, 2010. You may submit these requests by email or fax for your convenience. Leaders have the option of having half the deposit refunded or having the full deposit applied to the following year if cancellations are made on or prior to May 1st. After the May 1st deadline there will be no refunds or transfers of funds.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Upon receipt of your form you will receive a registration confirmation email stating the status of your campers/leaders, and a printable individual camper/leader application and health form for your campers/leaders. All camper/leader forms must be filled out completely and received in the registration office by 5 p.m. CST two weeks before your session begins. Incomplete forms will cause a delay in your registration. Forms with either the original or copied parent/guardian signatures may be submitted.

If enough spaces are not available for your campers/leaders, the individuals will be placed on a wait list pending future openings. If you have wait list Campers/Leaders and there are openings for them to attend camp, a confirmation fax/email will be sent that will need to be signed and faxed back by the stated deadline. Calls to check your status are unnecessary. If you accept wait list spaces in less than 10 days before camp begins, you must bring the full payment on opening day.

Please understand that you are to bring only those campers/leaders who have been approved by POINT 11. You are not to bring any wait list or additional campers/leaders. A fine will be assessed to your account if any non-approved campers/leaders are brought.

WHAT NEEDS TO BE SUBMITTED

We require that the following documents be received in our offices no later than 5 p.m. CST two weeks prior to your session:

- **Completed Camper and Leader Individual Forms.**
 - An individual camper/leader application and health form must be completed for each attendee you plan to bring.
 - Please note that incomplete forms will delay your registration as we work with you to gain the completed registration.
 - Please refer to the “Who Can Attend” section of this Policy Agreement for guidance concerning attendee restrictions.

- **Proof of insurance for each person you bring.**

- You may submit either individual insurance for each person or you may send proof of group coverage.

It is your responsibility to make sure all campers from your group who attend POINT 11 are covered by private or group insurance. You are liable for every camper you bring to camp.

- **Final Payment.**

- Your entire final payment must be received by this time otherwise you will risk the loss of your registered spaces.

ADDITIONAL FACTS

If your reserved spaces are not filled by your camp date you will lose the tuition money you have paid.

24-48 hours before your session begins, a completed list of all registered campers/leaders will be faxed to verify the following information: number of campers/leaders who are attending camp, their names, gender, birth dates. It is important to verify that all the information on the list is correct by 3 p.m. CST the day before your session begins and again by 10 a.m. CST on opening day.

Arriving to camp on time is imperative to the camp program. On the opening day of your camp session, you need to arrive between 2 p.m. CST and 4 p.m. CST. Late arrival will greatly disrupt the program and you will miss out on important information.

A group leader or administrator may not begin a new group unless accounts from the previous year(s) or Point 11’s affiliate camps have been settled and show a zero balance or credit.

Point 11 reserves the right to change a Camper’s Cabin placement as we deem appropriate, at any given time before or after camp begins.

Point 11 will operate the snack shack and merchandise booth, so additional funds may be brought for these services.
